

Conveniently located just 150m from Epping train station, Levande's *The Cambridge* is a revolutionary new development that will serve multiple needs.

Currently under construction, when complete next year *The Cambridge* will be home to 172 independent living units and a 132-bed aged care facility. Rising 28 storeys, this vertical village currently ranks as the tallest of its kind in NSW and is the latest project from Levande, one of Australia's top three retirement living providers.

Levande's vision, explains Rivera, is to create a truly intergenerational development. "There is a K-6 primary school on the broader site, which we are upgrading as part of the project. This provides us with opportunities to run activities that will benefit both groups," she says.

With a church and retail outlets also nearby, the result will be a vibrant precinct in Sydney's leafy northern suburbs where residents can enjoy all the benefits of an inner-city lifestyle.

The Cambridge has a selection of one-, two-, two-plus-study and three-bedroom apartments, as well as penthouse suites. "We are releasing a limited number of apartments in stages," Rivera

The benefit of the highrise design also means residents "are only an elevator ride away from all the amenities we offer," she says, referring to social hubs such as the exclusive resident clubhouse and bar, alfresco lounge with gourmet BBQ facilities and rooftop entertainment space. There's also going to be a fitness centre, heated swimming pool, games room with billiards, luxury cinema, library and even a hair salon, vegetable garden, and workshed.

Residents of *The Cambridge* will enjoy new programs, which will provide dedicated attention to residents' wellbeing "from the day they move in - whether it's social or sporting activities, leisure pursuits, assistance with activities of daily living, or, later on, a higher level of care when and as needed."

says, adding they have already sold more than half of Stage One. "Given the carefully considered and subtly age-appropriate layouts, combined with the premium fixtures, fittings and facilities, we're not at all surprised that 60% have already been snapped up."

With excitement building around *The Cambridge*, Rivera says that Levande is hosting information sessions to meet public demand throughout August at the Epping club. "Places are limited and our previous info days have been fully booked - so we urge people to book a spot early."

Rivera says that *The Cambridge* is designed to "deliver the unparalleled quality of retirement living you deserve".




Donate and repurpose
